Local Scholarships...

American Legion Auxiliary

This scholarship is available to daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, nieces and sisters and step of the aforementioned, of any honorably discharged or deceased men/women veterans. Applicants must include a copy of the veteran's discharge papers, two letters of recommendation, a transcript of grades and a copy of income tax form or FAFSA. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 30, 2017.**

Jason Elowsky Memorial Scholarship

This scholarship has been developed to recognize the joy and vitality of life which Jason brought to our community to reward deserving students who might one day become significant contributors in their own right. The recipient of this scholarship must use the funds to meet educational expenses at a school of higher education. The applicant must reside within Montmorency County and entering the law enforcement field. Other fields of study will be considered as well. Michigan Association of Retired School Personnel

Applicants must also have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Priority will be given to applicants who pursue a career in conservation or law enforcement oriented areas. Kelsey's Law Scholarship

In October, 2017, \$5000 worth of scholarships will be awarded to Michigan students. Applicants are asked to submit a persuasive message that shows how they would convince young drivers to reduce distractions while driving. Messages may be in the form of a video, graphic, or Tweet that resonates with teens and influences their driving behavior. Entries will be judged and critiqued on the following factors: 1) Ability to persuade others, especially teen drivers, to stop texting while driving, 2) Ability to grab the attention of your friends, peers, and family, 3) A clear and understandable message, 4) Demonstration of your personal creativity and ingenuity. This scholarship is open to 11th and 12th grade students attending any public or private Michigan high school and have a Michigan driver's license.
