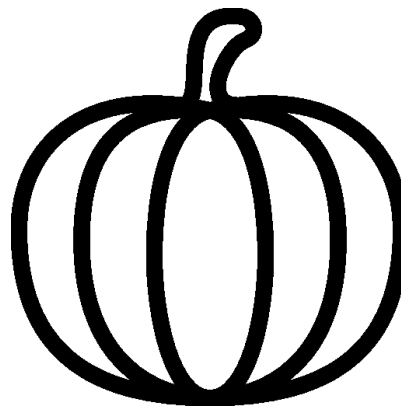
- ⇒ *\$5.00 towards every child's end of the year fieldtrip and/or activity,*
