Local Scholarships...

American Legion Auxiliary

This scholarship is available to daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, nieces and sisters and step of the aforementioned, of any honorably discharged or deceased men/women veterans. Applicants must include a copy of the veteran's discharge papers, two letters of recommendation, a transcript of grades and a copy of income tax form or FAFSA. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 30, 2018.**

Johannesburg Volunteer Fire Department Merit Award

The Johannesburg Volunteer Fire Department Merit Award provides a monetary award to a deserving senior from the Johannesburg-Lewiston High School. This is in memory of Peggy Koronka. To be considered for this award, you must be a senior at JLHS, demonstrate community service, volunteer work and selfless acts. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 16, 2018.**

Michigan Association of Retired School Personnel

Northland Sportsmen's Club Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to one graduating female and one graduating male student attending high school in Otsego County. Applicants must be accepted by an accredited post-secondary institution and provide evidence of having met the goals of the Northland Sportsmen's Club (preservation of the environment, upholding the game laws of the state, safe and proper use of firearms, outstanding citizenship and true sportsmanship). Applicants must also have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Priority will be given to applicants who pursue a career in conservation or law enforcement oriented areas. Oiler Youth Athlete Award

This scholarship is for students with a GPA of 3.0 or higher who have participated in Oiler youth football or cheerleading for a minimum of 1 year. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 4, 2018.**

Zonta Club of Gaylord Area Scholarship

This scholarship is available to any female who is a graduating senior who attends a high school in Otsego County and is pursuing a higher education. Applications are in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 11, 2018.**

MCAN Northeast Michigan Regional Prosperity Collaborative and Innovative Program Grant

Students in 11 counties across Northeast Michigan will have an opportunity to win a \$1000 scholarship for college or career training. Eleven scholarships will be awarded in total, one in each county of the region. To enter the scholarship competition, students must complete a survey. The survey will benchmark information about challenges, interest and opportunities unique to students in Northeast Michigan pursuing college. The survey will be open from April 1 to May 10, 2018. Eligible participants must live in or attend school in Northeast Michigan and be planning to attend college or a credentialed job training program in 2018.
