Local Scholarships...

American Legion Auxiliary

This scholarship is available to daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, nieces and sisters and step of the aforementioned, of any honorably discharged or deceased men/women veterans. Applicants must include a copy of the veteran's discharge papers, two letters of recommendation, a transcript of grades and a copy of income tax form or FAFSA. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 30, 2019.**

Bruce and Marian Huston Family Scholarship

This scholarship is available to a JLHS senior who plans to attend Lake Superior State University. To be considered, a student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The amount the recipient receives varies year to year. Last year it was \$5000. That same amount is renewable 3 or more times as long as the GPA requirements set by LSSU are met. Applications will be available in the guidance office in January. **Deadline: March 2019.**

Brush Creek Writers – Student Writing Contest

Students in grades 7-12 can compete for a total of 5 awards, four \$100 awards and one \$200 award. Entries must address the prompt, "to be free..." in some way, not necessarily directly. For other entry requirements, pick up an information sheet from Mrs. Nowak. **Deadline: February 28, 2019.**

Community Financial Margaret Dunning, Ron Carlson and George Lawton Scholarships

Community Financial Scholarship Fund will be awarding 20 - \$1500 scholarships in 2019. You could be one of those recipients! Johannesburg-Lewiston Education Association Scholarship

The teaching staff of Johannesburg-Lewiston Schools gives this scholarship to one senior per year. To be eligible, students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and be pursuing higher education in a certified college, business, trade or technical school. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 1, 2019.**

Kiwanis Club of Gaylord Foundation

This \$1000 scholarship is intended for someone who is involved in community service. Applicants for this scholarship must completely fill out an application (available in the guidance office) and submit it along with the following 3 attachments; (1) A letter or recommendation from an individual in your community relating to the service you've provided our community, (2) A resume and personal statement which includes scholastic, extracurricular, civic and employment data, (3) A high school transcript. Include any information regarding honors and awards. Include in your personal statement any information that would encourage the Kiwanis Club of Gaylord Foundation, a community service organization, to select you for this scholarship. **Deadline: March 23, 2019.**

Lewiston Garden Club

The Lewiston Garden Club offers this scholarship of \$500 to any JLHS senior pursuing a post-secondary education. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 15, 2019.**

Lewiston Lions/Lioness

EDWARD AND FRANCES BURZYNSKI SCHOLARSHIP (\$500): Awarded to a student planning on continuing their education at an accredited institution to study agriculture, veterinary science, forestry or a related field. Open to any Otsego County graduating senior.

KATIE KRUG YOUTH VOLUNTEERISM SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000): Awarded to a student who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment of time and effort to volunteerism in our community and is pursuing higher education at a college, university or technical school. Open to any Otsego County graduating students.

DONALD H. & HELEN S. CRANDALL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500): Awarded to graduating high school seniors in Otsego County, who plan to continue their education and pursue a career in secondary education.

REACH Scholarship (\$500): Awarded to a student demonstrating financial need. Open to Otsego County Students.

ATHEL EUGENE & HELEN WILLIAMS NURSING SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000): Awarded to a graduating senior pursuing a 4-year nursing or medical degree. Open to any Otsego County graduating student.

DON SKOP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500): Awarded to Otsego County high school graduates who have a 2.0 GPA or better and will be attending an accredited institution to continue education in a vocational field or skilled trade. Open to any Otsego County graduating students.

Presque Isle Electric and Gas Community First Fund

Applicants must be a legal dependent of a Presque Isle Electric and Gas member or residing with a PIE&G member for at least 12 months prior to applying for the scholarship and graduate in 2019. Alpena Community College

Alpena Community College offers a variety of scholarships for students who are planning to attend there in the fall of 2019. Central Michigan University Lem Tucker Scholarship

Students must have a GPA of 3.5 or better and complete the National Co-op Scholarship program application, including a typed one-page essay describing why you have chosen a college cooperation education program.
