Local Scholarships...

American Legion Auxiliary

This scholarship is available to daughters, granddaughters, great-granddaughters, nieces and sisters and step of the aforementioned, of any honorably discharged or deceased men/women veterans. Applicants must include a copy of the veteran's discharge papers, two letters of recommendation, a transcript of grades and a copy of income tax form or FAFSA. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 30, 2019.**

Garland Charity Classic Scholarship

This scholarship is offered to graduating seniors to encourage professional development. Financial support is provided for enrollment in an accredited undergraduate academic program leading to a degree. Applicants must be a high school graduate of either JLHS or Atlanta HS and must provide evidence of enrollment in a university, college or junior college for the 2019-2020 school year. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

Applications must be postmarked by May 13, 2019.

Gaylord Area Chamber of Commerce Culinary Arts Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must be an Otsego County resident and have a high school diploma or equivalent. Applicants must have already been accepted into a higher education facility and include an acceptance letter. Applicants must be pursuing a career in Culinary Arts. Two letters of recommendations indicating dedication to planned career and/or past community involvement through volunteerism. Applicants must provide a letter written by himself/herself stating the reason that they are applying for this scholarship. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 1, 2019.**

Johannesburg Volunteer Fire Department Merit Award

This merit award is given in memory of Peggy Koronka. To be considered, you must be a senior at Johannesburg-Lewiston High School and demonstrate community service, volunteer work and selfless acts. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 15, 2019.**

Lakes Scholarship

This scholarship is for graduating seniors planning to attend an in-state trade school, college or university in the fall of 2019. Applicants must complete an application, including an essay, and prove enrollment in their post-secondary school. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 26, 2019.**

Northland Sportsmen's Club Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to provide financial assistance to one graduating female and one graduating male student attending high school in Otsego County. Applicants must be accepted by an accredited post-secondary institution. Preference will be given to, but not limited to, those who provide evidence of having a love of the outdoors, preservation of the environment, obeying game laws of the state, and safe and proper use of firearms. Applicants must also exhibit outstanding citizenship and true sportsmanship. Applicants must also have a GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applications are in the guidance office. **Deadline: Postmarked by April 26, 2019.**

This scholarship is for students who have participated in Oiler youth football or cheerleading for a minimum of 1 year. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: May 15, 2019.**
