Ave Maria University Michigan Scholarship

Ave Maria University is a Catholic, liberal arts institution located in Ave Maria, Florida. This \$7000 yearly scholarship is available, in addition to any merit-based and/or athletic scholarships for which the applicant may qualify, and is renewable for four years if the recipient maintains a university GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applicants must have a 2.8 GPA or above and an ACT score of 22+ or a SAT score of 1100+. Applicants must also be a practicing Catholic (endorsement letter from parish). Interested students must be accepted to Ave Maria University and complete the online scholarship application at <https://www.avemaria.edu/future-students/scholarships/#michigan>.

Central Michigan University

Central Michigan University offers a number of scholarships for high school seniors pursuing their education at CMU in the fall. Most freshmen awards are renewable for up to four consecutive academic years as long as the criterion is met. For more information, visit https://www.cmich.edu/ess/OSFA/Pages/CMU_Scholarships.aspx. Scholarships are given on a first come first serve basis. **Student must apply to CMU early for consideration.**

Merit scholarships for freshmen:

- Academic Prestige Award: \$6000/year, renewable for 4 years (≥ 3.25 GPA and ≥ 1250 on SAT or 27+ on ACT)
- Academic Excellence Award: \$4500/year, renewable for 4 years (≥ 3.00 GPA and ≥ 1100 on SAT or 23+ on ACT)
- Academic Success Award: \$3000/year, renewable for 4 years (≥ 3.00 GPA and ≥ 1040 on SAT or 21+ on ACT)

Centralis Scholarship Competition

High school students with a GPA of 3.7 or higher and a SAT of 1260 or higher (or an ACT score of 27+) are invited to compete for Centralis Scholar or Centralis Gold Awards. Reservations must be made to participate in this competition. For additional information, contact the Admissions Office at CMU at 1-888-292-5366.

CMU Leader Advancement Scholarship

There are 40 of these scholarships given to students with a minimum GPA of 3.0 and a record of leadership in school and community. This award is for \$2000 per year renewable for 3 additional years.

Credit Union ONE of Michigan

Seniors who have a family member who has belonged to Credit Union ONE for a minimum of 6 months may be eligible to apply for their scholarship. The student must also have completed 30 or more of documented, qualified community service during their Junior/Senior years of high school, ending April 2019. GPA must be at least a 3.0 and the student must be planning to attend college in the fall on 2019 as a full time student. Presidential Scholarships

Awards ranging from \$4,000 to \$7,000 a year, for up to four consecutive years are available to high school graduates with a 3.8 GPA and a SAT of 1430+ or ACT of 32+. Applicants must complete the admissions application by the December 31st scholarship deadline. Eligible students must participate in the scholarship competition. Recipients also automatically receive the Award for Excellence Scholarship. **Deadline: December 31, 2018.**

Faculty Scholarships

Awards ranging from \$1000 to \$3,000 a year for up to four consecutive years are available to high school graduates with a 3.6 GPA and a SAT of 1370+ or ACT of 30+. Applicants must complete the admissions application by the December 31st scholarship deadline. Eligible students must participate in the scholarship competition. Recipients also automatically receive the Award for Excellence Scholarship. **Deadline: December 31, 2018.**

Award of Excellence

This scholarship provides \$5000 a year for up to 4 years. Recipients of this award must have a 3.5 GPA and a SAT of 1240+ or ACT of 26+ and a complete admission application to Grand Valley by December 31st. Students must be graduates of Michigan high schools and Grand Valley must be the first institution they attend following high school graduation. **Deadline: December 31, 2018.**

Laker Scholarship

This scholarship provides \$2000 a year for up to 4 years. Recipients must have a 3.3 GPA and a SAT of 1140+ or an ACT of 23+ and a complete admission application to Grand Valley by **December 31st**. This scholarship is renewable for three additional years (eight consecutive semesters total) provided the student maintains a 2.85 grade point average at Grand Valley.

Horatio Alger Michigan Scholarship Program

As one of the nation's largest need-based college scholarship programs in the country, the Horatio Alger Scholarship Programs specifically assist high school students who have faced and overcome great obstacles in their young lives. While many programs are directed primarily to recognizing academic achievement or leadership potential, the Horatio Alger Association seeks students who have exhibited determination, integrity, and perseverance in overcoming adversity, as well as have critical financial need. Applications must be completed online at <https://scholars.horatioalger.org/>. **Deadline: October 25, 2018.**

JL to MSU Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2003-04 by Mr. Alfred C. West Jr. and Mr. Stephen R. Poland. It is awarded to a student who graduates from JLHS and continues their education at Michigan State University. There is no application for the scholarship. Students who apply to MSU are automatically considered for the award. The amount of the award varies from year to year.

Lake Superior State University (based on 2017-18 scholarships)

Eligibility is automatically evaluated by the Financial Aid Office for all students admitted by May 1st for the following academic year. All recipients in this section are selected by the Financial Aid Committee and may choose any degree curriculum offered by the University. Scholarships are awarded based on a point scale that is approved annually by the Financial Aid Committee. Fifty percent weight is given to the overall high school GPA and 50 percent is based on the highest ACT composite score received by May 1. Renewable scholarships are based on the recipient meeting the renewal criteria. For more info, visit <http://www.lssu.edu/finaid/scholarship.php>.

Laker Gold Scholarship

Value: Full Tuition up to 17 credits per semester, inclusive of other LSSU awards, renewable. Up to three scholarships will be awarded each year through the Lake Gold Competition.

Criteria: must meet Board of Trustees Distinguished Scholarship criteria, must have applied for admission no later than December 1st of senior year of high school, must be invited to attend annual competition and respond by invitation due date.

Board of Trustees Distinguished Scholarship

Value: up to \$9,000 per year (\$5,000 + \$4,000 if Room & Board) – renewable

Criteria: merit based; minimum points 180 (example: 3.80 GPA and 1310 SAT or 28 ACT)

Board of Trustees Academic Excellence Scholarship

Value: up to \$7,000 per year (\$3,000 + \$4,000 if Room & Board) – renewable

Criteria: merit based; 173.5 – 179.99 points (example: 3.70 GPA and 1280 SAT or 27 ACT)

Board of Trustees Academic Honors Scholarship

Value: up to \$6,000 per year (\$2,000 + \$4,000 if Room & Board) – renewable

Criteria: merit based; 158.5 – 173.49 points (example: 3.50 GPA and 1200 SAT or 25 ACT)

Board of Trustees Academic Recognition Scholarship

Value: up to \$4,000 per year (\$2,000 + \$2,000 if Room & Board) – renewable

Criteria: merit based; 128.5 – 158.49 points (example: 3.30 GPA and 1060 SAT or 21 ACT)

Board of Trustees Academic Achievement Scholarship

Value: up to \$3,000 per year (\$1,000 + \$2,000 if Room & Board) – renewable

Criteria: merit based; 102.0 – 128.49 points (example: 2.8 GPA and 980 SAT or 19 ACT)

LSSU - Bruce and Marian Huston Family Scholarship

This scholarship is available to a JLHS senior who plans to attend Lake Superior State University. To be considered, a student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The amount the recipient receives varies year to year. Last year it was \$5000. That same amount is renewable 3 or more times as long as the GPA requirements set by LSSU are met.

Applications will be available in the guidance office in January. **Deadline: March, 2019.**

MHSAA-Farm Bureau Insurance Scholar-Athlete Award

Students must be a senior and participating in interscholastic athletics at an MHSAA member school. The student must have, prior to senior year, won a varsity letter in a sport in which the MHSAA sponsors a post-season tournament. The student must also have a minimum GPA of at least a 3.5 without rounding. Information is available online at <http://www.mhsaa.com/schools/students/scholar-athlete-award>. President's Scholarship – 100% tuition and required fees

This is the university's most prestigious award. To be considered, qualified scholars complete a written essay at a required scholarship competition. Final selection of recipients is made in February. To compete, you must have one of the following:

- 3.9+ GPA with 1270 SAT/28+ ACT (or)
- 1350+ SAT/30+ ACT with minimum 3.00 GPA (or)
- Ranked #1 or #2 in class with minimum 3.00 GPA

Founders Scholarship - \$5000/year for 4 years – 3.6+ GPA with 1200+SAT/26+ ACT

Dean's Scholarship - \$4000/year for 4 years – 3.00+ GPA with 1120+SAT or 24+ ACT

Cardinal Scholarship - \$3000/year for 4 years – 3.00+ GPA with 1060+ SAT or 22+ ACT

University Scholarship - \$2000/year for 4 yrs – 3.70+ GPA + any test score **OR** 3.00+ GPA and 900+ SAT/18+ ACT

University of Michigan - Go Blue Guarantee

If your family income is \$65,000 or under and you apply and are admitted to U-M, your FULL in-state tuition will be paid for! That is a \$60,000 value. Visit <https://goblueguarantee.umich.edu/> to learn if you qualify.

VFW Voice of Democracy Scholarship Program

This scholarship is open to students in grades 9-12. Voice of Democracy audio-essay program provides high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. This year's theme is "Why My Vote Matters". District winners advance to the state level. The state winner are invited to Washington D.C., where their audio essays compete in the finals competition. Applications are available from guidance office. **Deadline: October 31, 2018.**

Medallion Scholarship

Value: \$15,000 annually (\$60,000 total award)

Criteria: 3.7+ cumulative GPA **AND** 26+ ACT composite or SAT of 1240

Qualified students will be invited to register for the competition – up to 20 awards given annually.

Presidential Academic Excellence Scholarship

Value: \$5,000 for year 1 and 2, \$7,500 for year 3 and 4 (\$25,000 total award)

Criteria: 3.7+ cumulative GPA **AND** 26+ ACT composite or SAT of 1240+

Up to 40 awards given annually to semi-finalists in the Medallion Competition.

Bronco Merit Scholarship

Value: \$2,500 annually (\$10,000 total award)

Criteria: 3.4+ cumulative GPA **AND** 23+ ACT composite or SAT of 1140+

Up to 300 awards given annually. (New this year: All students participating in the Medallion competition will receive, at minimum, a Bronco Merit Scholarship.)

Burger King Scholarships

Burger King Scholar

The requirements for this scholarship are to have a minimum GPA of 2.5, be passionate about serving the community, be a high school senior, and be a Burger King Employee or child of an Burger King Employee. The requirements for this scholarship are to have a minimum GPA of 3.3 and an ACT score of 25+ or a combined SAT score of 1200, demonstrate an active leadership role in community service, athletics and/or similar co-curricular activity (such as student government, team sports, etc.) and demonstrate substantial work experience. Scholarships range from \$1000-\$50,000. The application will be online beginning October 15 at

Cooperative Education Scholarships

The National Co-op Scholarship Program awards many scholarships for students attending one of the following 11 colleges: Clarkson University, Drexel University, Johnson & Wales, Merrimack College, Rochester Institute of Technology, State University of New York Oswego, University of Cincinnati, University of Toledo, or Wentworth Institute of Technology. Students must have a GPA of 3.5 or better and complete the National Co-op Scholarship program application, including a typed one-page essay describing why you have chosen a college cooperation education program. It is strongly recommended that you apply early if you are interested in a co-op scholarship. Apply online at www.waceinc.org. **Deadline: February 15, 2019.**

Elks National Foundation 2017 Most Valuable Student Scholarship

Applicants for this scholarship must complete an application and provide the other requested documents. There are 500 awards available, all renewable for 4 years. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$12,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university. Many local Lodges, districts and state Elks associations award their own scholarships through this program. These scholarships are not to be confused with the 500 Elks National Foundation Most Valuable Student Scholarships. Hagan Scholarship

The purpose of this scholarship is to provide each recipient with opportunity to obtain a four-year college education and graduate debt free. To be eligible, students must have a 3.5+ GPA, an ACT score of 23 or higher or a 1200+ on the SAT, must work 240+ hours in the 12 months prior to the start of college and must complete the FAFSA using 2017 tax information. The FAFSA EFC must be less than \$6500. Apply online at www.hsfmo.org. **Deadline: November 15, 2018.**
