## ***Local Scholarships...***

### **Bruce and Marian Huston Family Scholarship**

This scholarship is available to a JLHS senior who plans to attend Lake Superior State University. To be considered, a student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The amount the recipient receives varies year to year. That same amount is renewable 3 or more times as long as the GPA requirements set by LSSU are met. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: March 20, 2020.**

### **Brush Creek Writers – Student Writing Contest**

Students in grades 7-12 can compete for a total of 4 awards, three \$100 awards and one \$200 award. Entries must address the prompt, “water...” in some way, not necessarily directly. For other entry requirements, pick up an information sheet from Mrs. Nowak. **Deadline: March 15, 2020.**

### **Community Financial Margaret Dunning, Ron Carlson and George Lawton Scholarships**

Community Financial Scholarship Fund will be awarding 20 - \$1500 scholarships in 2020. You could be one of those recipients! Students must demonstrate the credit union’s “People Helping People” philosophy. Applicants must have their own personal Community Financial accounts and must have opened them on or before September 15, 2019. Students must be enrolled or anticipate enrollment in an accredited institution for the fall 2020 semester. ### **Garland Charity Classic Scholarship**

This scholarship is offered to graduating seniors to encourage professional development. Financial support is provided for enrollment in an accredited undergraduate academic program leading to a degree. Applicants must be a high school graduate of either JLHS or Atlanta HS and must provide evidence of enrollment in a university, college or junior college for the 2020-2021 school year. Incomplete and late applications will not be considered.

**Applications must be postmarked by April 15, 2020.**

### **Johannesburg-Lewiston Education Association Scholarship**

The teaching staff of Johannesburg-Lewiston Schools gives this scholarship to one senior per year. To be eligible, students must have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and be pursuing higher education in a certified college, business, trade or technical school. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 1, 2020.**

### **JL to MSU Scholarship**

This scholarship was established in 2003-04 by Mr. Alfred C. West Jr. and Mr. Stephen R. Poland. It is awarded to a student who graduates from JLHS and continues their education at Michigan State University. There is no application for the scholarship. Students who apply to MSU are automatically considered for the award. The amount of the award varies from year to year.

### **Kiwanis Club of Gaylord Foundation**

This \$1000 scholarship is intended for someone who is involved in community service. Applicants for this scholarship must completely fill out an application (available in the guidance office) and submit it along with the following 3 attachments; (1) A letter or recommendation from an individual in your community relating to the service you’ve provided our community, (2) A resume and personal statement which includes scholastic, extracurricular, civic and employment data, (3) A high school transcript. Include any information regarding honors and awards. Include in your personal statement any information that would encourage the Kiwanis Club of Gaylord Foundation, a community service organization, to select you for this scholarship. **Deadline: March 20, 2020.**

### **Lakes Scholarship**

This scholarship is for graduating seniors planning to attend an in-state trade school, college or university in the fall of 2019. Applicants must complete an application, including an essay, and prove enrollment in their post-secondary school. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 24, 2020.**

### **Lewiston Garden Club**

The Lewiston Garden Club offers this scholarship of \$500 to any JLHS senior pursuing a post-secondary education. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 15, 2020.**

### **Lewiston Lions/Lioness**

The Lewiston Lions/Lioness Clubs have several \$1000 scholarships available to seniors who have been accepted to a post-secondary college. Applications are available in the guidance office. **Deadline: April 15, 2020.**

**LOUIS AND ROSE MARIE TEBBE MEMORIAL:** Awarded to a hard-working student. Preference given to students of military families or those pursuing a medical career. Open to all Otsego County students.

**EDWARD AND FRANCES BURZYNSKI SCHOLARSHIP (\$500):** Awarded to a student planning on continuing their education at an accredited institution to study agriculture, veterinary science, forestry or a related field. Open to any Otsego County graduating senior.

**KATIE KRUG YOUTH VOLUNTEERISM SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000):** Awarded to a student who has demonstrated an outstanding commitment of time and effort to volunteerism in our community and is pursuing higher education at a college, university or technical school. Open to any Otsego County graduating students.

**DONALD H. & HELEN S. CRANDALL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500):** Awarded to graduating high school seniors in Otsego County, who plan to continue their education and pursue a career in secondary education.

**REACH Scholarship (\$500):** Awarded to a student demonstrating financial need. Open to Otsego County Students.

**ATHEL EUGENE & HELEN WILLIAMS NURSING SCHOLARSHIP (\$1000):** Awarded to a graduating senior pursuing a 4-year nursing or medical degree. Open to any Otsego County graduating student.

**DON SKOP MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP (\$500):** Awarded to Otsego County high school graduates who have a 2.0 GPA or better and will be attending an accredited institution to continue education in a vocational field or skilled trade. Open to any Otsego County graduating students.

## VFW Scholarship

The VFW Post 1518 will be awarding 4 - \$1000 scholarships at a special dinner on Saturday, April 25, 2020. This scholarship is available to the child or grandchild of a veteran who is planning to attend an accredited college or university and has a GPA of 3.0+. ## **State Scholarships...**

### Credit Union ONE of Michigan

Seniors who have a family member who has belonged to Credit Union ONE for a minimum of 6 months may be eligible to apply for their scholarship. The student must also have completed 30 or more of documented, qualified community service during their Junior/Senior years of high school, ending April 2020. GPA must be at least a 3.0 and the student must be planning to attend college in the fall on 2019 as a full-time student. ## Kirtland Community College

Kirtland offers two scholarships based on GPA and SAT scores. No application is required. You just have to apply for admission, attend orientation and register as a full-time student. If you have a GPA of 3.5+ and an SAT of 1100+, you will receive \$1000 per semester (or \$2000/year). If you have a GPA of 3.25+ and a SAT of 900+, you will receive \$500 per semester (or \$1000/year).

## Michigan Mosquito Control Association – Kenley Farrel Memorial Scholarship

Are you interested in science? To qualify for this scholarship, students must be a Michigan resident, have a GPA of 2.5 or higher and plan to attend a Michigan College/University. Applicants must complete an application and submit an essay concerning. ## Michigan Retailers Association

### Jack and Dorothy Harris Scholarship

This NCMC Scholarship is intended for a local high school graduate who enrolls full-time in NCMC as a degree seeking student. Recipients must maintain a GPA of 2.0 each semester and must continue to meet the criteria for the scholarship for it to be renewed each semester. ## TC Energy Scholarship

Students from JLHS are eligible to apply for this scholarship if they are planning to go to college in the fall and are NOT dependents of someone employed by TC Energy. ## National Scholarships...

### Cooperative Education Scholarships

The National Co-op Scholarship Program awards many scholarships for students attending one of the following 11 colleges: Clarkson University, Drexel University, Johnson & Wales, Merrimack College, Rochester Institute of Technology, State University of New York Oswego, University of Cincinnati, University of Toledo, or Wentworth Institute of Technology. Students must have a GPA of 3.5 or better and complete the National Co-op Scholarship program application, including a typed one-page essay describing why you have chosen a college cooperation education program.
