Big News for school year 2021-2022:

Breakfast and Lunch are offered at no-charge to JLAS students this school year.

(Unless you received a letter stating that you do not need to, please return the completed application for free and reduced-price meals to the school. The meals are offered at no-charge, but we still need applications returned because that does affect school funding.)

Extra milk or “Just a Milk” can be purchased for \$.40

(The child must have funds in their lunch account or sufficient cash in hand when buying “just a milk”.)

Ala carte or extra entrée’s may be purchased, if/when offered, for an additional cost if the child has funds in their account or sufficient cash in hand.

Reminder:

Breakfast and lunch offered at no-charge are full meals only; “just a milk” or “milk only” is not free. Charging “just a milk”, extra milk, ala carte food items, and extras is not allowed.

The GREAT NEWS is that ALL students enrolled at our school can receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at NO CHARGE to your household each day.

We still need your household to **fill out and sign the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Application**. This information is *critical* in determining the amount of money that our school receives from a variety of State and Federal supplemental programs like Title I A, At-risk (31a), Title II A, E-Rate, etc.

These supplemental programs have the potential to offer supports and services for our students which may include, but are not limited to:

- Instructional supports (staff, supplies & materials, etc.)
- Non-instructional services (counseling, social work, health services, etc.)
- Professional Learning for staff
- Parent and Community engagement supplies and activities
- Technology
- Pandemic-EBT

Up to date free/reduced price meal eligibility may also help high school students with:

- waivers for college testing fees, college application fees, application fees for non-federal financial aid services
- help to qualify students for career training programs

We are asking that you please complete and submit the Free and Reduced-Price Meal Application as soon as possible to ensure that additional funding for our school is available to meet the needs of our students. All information on the application submitted is confidential. Without your assistance in completing and returning the attached application, our school cannot maximize the use of available State and Federal funds.
