### Current Classes

As I shared in the accompanying letter that applies to seniors as well, seniors who were passing a class as of March 11 will receive “credit” for the current semester. No letter grades will be given out. “Credit” for this semester will not be counted for, or against, your GPA.

- *Seniors that were NOT passing a class required for graduation as of March 11 will have the opportunity to work individually with their teacher to redo, update, modify, produce, assignments getting them to a passing status in order to earn “credit” in that class.* Seniors not passing a required class for graduation, as of March 11 will have until May 31 to complete the necessary work. (Get it done sooner than later!) Teachers will be in contact with you, if they haven’t already, to discuss a plan to get you passing, in order to receive “credit” in your class and be eligible for your HS diploma.
