Google Classrooms will be updated daily by 8:30 a.m. with brief activities for the day. Teachers have “office hours” established and you will find them in this packet. During these times, they are available to help you and your child, answer any questions you may have, and possibly meet with your child individually to check in on their progress.

If you are not on-line, your child’s teacher will be sending a paper packet that is comparable with the online activities. We will be sending a packet to all K-2 students because we know that their capabilities to navigate an online platform may be limited! If you find that they want to use the on-line platform, that is perfectly fine!

As the stay at home order is lifted, we will be developing a plan for getting personal items that students left at school returned to them.
