

## **ONLINE COURSES**

Online education in the Johannesburg-Lewiston Area Schools is available through E20/20 (Edgenuity), Michigan Virtual High School and *Great Lakes Online Education* (GLOE). Online courses are available as needed and are approved on an individual basis. These courses are intended to supplement our current course offerings, not replace them.

### **E-2020/Edgenuity**

We offer credit recovery for many of our core courses through an online program called E-2020 or Edgenuity. Students who have previously taken a core course but did not receive credit may be scheduled to retake the course through the E-2020 program. This program allows greater flexibility in scheduling and an alternative method of instruction. Students work independently on the computer for course credit.
