

Parent/Guardian, please, **only fill out one Household Information Report per household.**

While breakfast and lunch are being offered at no-charge to all students in the district without requiring an application, the free/reduced price meal status used for other programs can only be determined by completing, and submitting, the Household Information Report, and a meal status determined (unless you received a letter asking you not to fill out a Household Information Report). Meals offered at “no-charge” does not mean your child automatically has free/reduced meal status. It does make a difference.

To maintain confidentiality, return the completed report to the office in an envelope addressed to the Food Service Department, or complete the report online if you have your PS1000 online portal information.

“Just a milk” is not free and cannot be charged. Students must have money in their food service account or \$.50 in hand to purchase “just a milk”.
