

Local Scholarships...

JL to MSU Scholarship

This scholarship was established in 2003-04 by Mr. Alfred C. West Jr. and Mr. Stephen R. Poland. It is awarded to a student who graduates from JLHS and continues their education at Michigan State University. There is no application for the scholarship. Students who apply to MSU are automatically considered for the award. The amount of the award varies from year to year.

LSSU - Bruce and Marian Huston Family Scholarship

This scholarship is available to a JLHS senior who plans to attend Lake Superior State University. To be considered, a student must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher. The amount the recipient receives varies year to year. In previous years, the award has been up to \$5000. That same amount is renewable 3 or more times as long as the GPA requirements set by LSSU are met. Applications will be available in the guidance office in January.

Deadline: March 2023.

MENSA of Northern Michigan

The MENSA Foundation works to identify and foster human intelligence for the benefit of humanity and to encourage research into the nature, characteristics, and uses of intelligence. MENSA gives over 100 scholarships annually, based on the merit of a short, 550-word essay submission. Essays are submitted online at <https://www.mensafoundation.org/what-we-do/scholarships/>. **Deadline: January 15, 2023.**

St Francis of Assisi

This scholarship is for graduating seniors who are active members of the St. Francis of Assisi Parish. Upon graduation, applicants must be working toward an accredited degree and enrolled in a two- or four-year undergraduate program or enrolled in post-secondary trade school. Applications will be available in the guidance office. **Deadline: March 1, 2023.**

NCMC's Tip of the Mitt Scholars Program

This scholarship is intended for first-generation students who will graduate high school with a 2.5 or higher GPA and are unsure if they want – or how they could afford – to attend college. First-generation students will be given preference; however, non-first-generation student may be considered as funding and space allow. This scholarship covers two years (four consecutive semesters) at North Central or completion of an associate degree or certificate program, whichever comes first. It includes tuition, mandatory fees, and books purchased through the College Bookstore. **Deadline: April 15, 2023.**

Otsego County United Way – Applications will be available soon for the two scholarships listed below.

Volunteer Center Scholarship – One \$500 scholarship is given per year and is renewable for four years up to \$2000. This scholarship is awarded to a student who has demonstrated history of volunteerism, with priority given to those who have completed volunteer service at Otsego County United Way or one of our partners.

JEDI Scholarship – Two \$1000 scholarship will be awarded in honor of Erin Mann, former OCUW Executive Director. This scholarship will go to students who represent the ideals of justice, equity, diversity and inclusion.

State/College Scholarships...

Ave Maria University Michigan Scholarship

Ave Maria University is a Catholic, liberal arts institution located in Ave Maria, Florida. This \$7000 yearly scholarship is available, in addition to any merit-based and/or athletic scholarships for which the applicant may qualify and is renewable for four years if the recipient maintains a university GPA of 2.5 or higher. Applicants must have a 3.0 GPA or above and an ACT score of 23+ or a SAT score of 1140+. Applicants must also be a practicing Catholic (endorsement letter from parish). Interested students must be accepted to Ave Maria University and complete the online scholarship application at <https://www.avemaria.edu/future-students/scholarships/#michigan>.

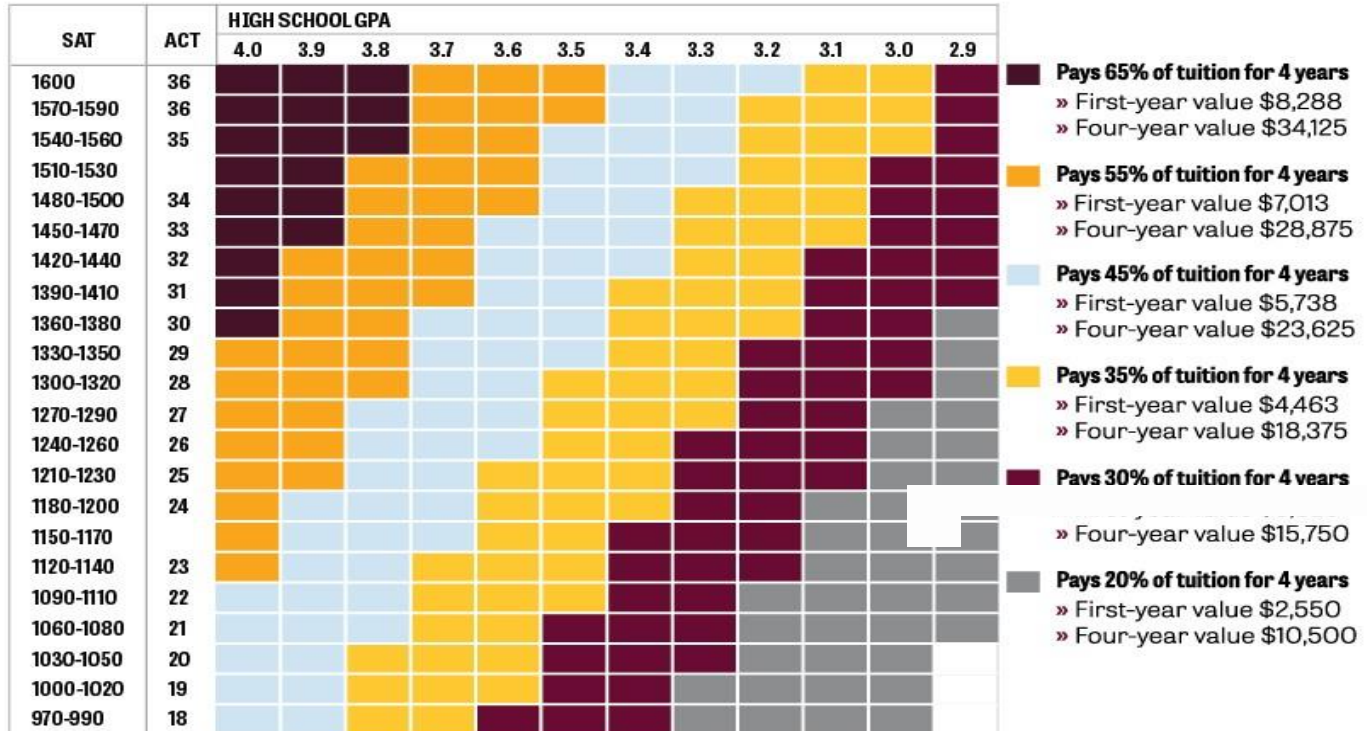
Central Michigan University

Presidential Scholarships

Annual awards of \$11,000, for up to four consecutive years are available to high school graduates that have a 3.8+ GPA and composite ACT score of 32+ or score of 1430+ on the SAT.

Faculty Scholarships

Annual awards of \$8,000, for up to four consecutive years are available to high school graduates that have a 3.6+ GPA and composite ACT score of 30+ or 1370+ on the SAT.

Award of Excellence

Annual awards of \$3500, for up to four years are available to high school graduates that have a 3.5+ GPA. Students must be graduates of a Michigan HS and GVSU must be the first institution they attend after graduation.

Laker Scholarship

Annual awards of \$1000, for up to four consecutive years are available to high school graduates that have a 3.3 or higher high school GPA

Early Awareness Scholarship

Recipients of this scholarships must have participated in TRiO Talent Search for at least 2 years and have at least a 3.0 GPA. Awards are for \$3000, renewable for three additional years.

Michigan Elks Association – Charitable Grand Fund – Gold Key Scholarship

This scholarship is intended to help special needs students leave high school and enter into college (2 or 4 year). Ultimately, the scholarship can be valued at \$8000 (\$2000/year, renewable). Applications are to be completed online at www.mielksgoldkey.org, and must be submitted with supporting documents **by December 1, 2022. (No exceptions!)**

Michigan Education Association

This scholarship is available to dependents of MEA members or MEA-Retired members in good standing or to students graduating from a Michigan high school that has a MEA bargaining unit. Applicants must attend a Michigan public community, 4-year degree-granting institution or vocational training institution that grants a degree, certification, or license. Those attending the following private institutions are also eligible: Baker College-Flint/Owosso; University of Detroit-Mercy; Adrian College; Finlandia University; and Albion College. Priority is given based on 1- academic achievement, 2- extra-curricular activities and 3- school & community service. Oakland University

To be considered for merit scholarships, Oakland University must receive your admission application, transcript and SAT or ACT score (if applicable) by the priority deadline of **July 1, 2023**. If you meet this deadline, you will automatically be considered for OU scholarships. Scholarship awards are based on your academic record, including GPA and SAT or ACT (if applicable) score, at the time of admission. You may submit updated transcripts and/or test scores for scholarship reconsideration until the scholarship deadline. The total amount of Oakland University institutional awards and benefits cannot exceed the cost of tuition (the Geographic Region Award is not included in this limitation of OU awards and benefits). Applicants for this scholarship must complete an application and provide the other requested documents. There are 500 awards available, all renewable for 4 years. Ranging from \$1,000 per year to \$12,500 per year, Most Valuable Student scholarships are for students pursuing a four-year degree, on a full-time basis (minimum of 12 semester hours), in a U.S. college or university.). Many local Lodges, districts and state Elks associations award their own scholarships through this program. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide each recipient with opportunity to obtain a four-year college education and graduate debt free. Six hundred Hagan Scholarships can be awarded in March 2023 if enough eligible applications are received. Finalists eligible for, but not awarded a Hagan Scholarship will receive \$2000. To be eligible, students must have a 3.5+ GPA, must work 240+ hours in the 12 months prior to the start of college, household AGI <\$85,000 and must complete the FAFSA.
